Supporting local schools and not-for-profits

We support the community through our annual Data Centre Community Action Grants programme and other direct funding for projects that put the power of technology to use for community benefit, give people the power to build strong, sustainable communities, and improve STEAM education.



Prioritising sustainability

Meta approaches sustainability from the ground up — from design and construction to operations — by prioritising energy efficiency and renewable energy, water stewardship, and responsibly managing the end of life of our equipment. Our Clonee Data Centre buildings achieved LEED® Gold certification, which requires meeting high standards for energy efficiency, renewable energy, water conservation, supply chain responsibility and recycling. The Clonee Data Centre also won Ireland's Green Construction Award.



Net zero emissions goals

Our goal is to reach net zero emissions across our global value chain in 2030. The operations of our data centres and offices have already reached net zero emissions, and our data centres' electricity use is matched with 100% clean and renewable energy through our strategy of adding renewables to the local grid, which also helps decarbonise the electricity system. This includes supporting two new solar energy projects in Meath and Wexford.

Community spotlight

Bridging the Digital Divide

We provided over €500K in grants in 2023-2024 to support community partners delivering programmes in Meath focused on building digital skills for learners of all ages, and supporting diversity, equality and inclusion, including:

- Creating **STEAM Meath** a fully funded STEAM programme for 11 primary and eight post-primary schools right across Meath — fostering STEAM capacity in schools through FIRST Lego League™.
- Supporting **Meath Women's Refuge & Support Services** to help women who have experienced domestic violence and control.
- Creating **Dunboyne Playground and Playspace Forum** to form an outdoor community space that the entire town can enjoy, both now and as Dunboyne grows.
