Partnering with Norrbotten

Meta is committed to being a good neighbour and community partner. We do this by supporting jobs and sourcing labour and materials locally where we can, and partnering with local chambers, small businesses and not-for-profit organisations.



Supporting local organisations

Meta supports the community through our annual Data Centre Community Action Grants programme providing direct funding for local nonprofits that support the community. Additionally, we bring our no-cost digital skills training workshops to Norrbotten, helping small businesses and nonprofits grow their reach.

Community spotlight: Supporting STEM education in Norrbotten

Meta has supported FIRST Scandinavia's initiative to build STEM capacity in Norrbotten schools with a donation of 2,630,000 SEK (approximately \$240,000 USD) in 2023. This programme has been running over several years to make STEM education accessible to children and youth aged 6-16 across the region through the global FIRST Lego League programme.

Our investment will enable:

- The delivery of teacher training and programming activities for students in all 14 municipalities of Norrbotten.
- Pop-up events and FIRST Lego League STEM competitions, fostering hands-on learning and excitement around technology.
- Distribution of robotic STEM kits to participating schools, with a focus on supporting schools in low-income areas.

The project addresses the ongoing teacher shortage in Sweden, particularly in technology subjects, by equipping educators and students with new resources and training. The goal was to establish two new FIRST Lego League tournaments in Norrbotten, creating a vibrant STEM education community and ensuring continued engagement in technology and innovation.



Operating Responsibly

We approach data centre sustainability from the ground up — from design and construction to operations — by prioritising energy efficiency, clean and renewable energy, water stewardship and responsible management of equipment across our global fleet at end-of-life. Our operational data centre buildings achieve LEED® Gold certification by focusing on efficiency, sustainability and innovation.



Net zero emissions goals

Our goal is to reach net zero emissions across our global value chain in 2030. Our data centres' electricity use is matched with 100% clean and renewable energy through our strategy of adding renewables to the grid, which also helps decarbonise the electricity system.
