

Meta Data Centre Community Action Grants

Meta's annual Data Centre Community Action Grants program provides direct funding to local public schools, nonprofits and community organizations for projects that:

- Address critical community needs by putting the power of technology to use for community benefit.
- Connect people online or off.
- Improve local science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) education.

Eligible organisations:



Registered not for profit organisations.



Government entities including local municipalities.



State-run schools.

What to keep in mind if you're applying for a grant:



Only one grant can be awarded per organisation per cycle, except schools.



Projects must have demonstrable metrics that can be publicly reported (how funds are used and their community impact).



Grants are awarded in the Spring and funds are intended to be used within one year of the grant award date.



Applications open on 11 September 2023 and close on 20 October 2023.
