# Partnering with Idaho

We are committed to supporting the community through sourcing labor and materials locally where we can, volunteering, partnering with local chambers, and supporting local schools, nonprofits and community projects.



## Supporting the community

Meta invested \$70 million to build a water and wastewater treatment system that has been given to the City of Kuna to own and operate. The system is now part of the infrastructure backbone to serve the recently annexed eastern side of the city. As a part of this facility, we also developed a water reuse system with the City of Kuna that will utilize our treated campus wastewater as irrigation water for non-edible crops, providing the city with enhanced flexibility to manage water demand.

We launched our annual Data Center Community Action Grants program in Kuna in fall 2024 to support projects that put the power of technology to use for community benefit, give people the power to build strong, sustainable communities, and improve STEAM education.



## Prioritizing sustainability

Meta approaches sustainability from the ground up — from design and construction to operations — by prioritizing energy efficiency and renewable energy, water stewardship, and responsibly managing the end of life of our equipment. Our operational data center buildings achieve LEED® Gold certification by focusing on efficiency, sustainability and innovation. We are working with Idaho Power to meet our 100% clean and renewable energy goal for the Kuna Data Center. This includes a new 200-megawatt solar project in Idaho, and the creation of a new green tariff under the Clean Energy Your Way program that is also available to other large customers looking to support their operations with renewable energy.



## Minimizing water use

We are proud to build some of the most sustainable data centers in the world and prioritize on-site water efficiency.

The Kuna Data Center will:

- Use cooling technology that is significantly more water efficient than the industry standard.
- Be landscaped with native vegetation where possible to reduce irrigation demands.
- Capture and infiltrate rainwater on site.
- Incorporate water-saving fixtures and technologies within data center facilities.



## Water restoration

Our goal is to restore more water than we consume to local watersheds. We are investing in water conservation and restoration projects, including supporting Trout Unlimited and Boise State University to construct the Alta Harris Creek side channel. This project increases flows to Alta Harris Creek and supports fish passage through the Barber Dam, habitat reestablishment and improved water quality.
